### **Eligibility**

Applicant's parents must be SkyLine members or SkyBest Communications telephone or broadband service customers of at least one year, and family must reside full-time in the companies' service area. Two area high school juniors will be sponsored this year.

### **Other Program Requirements**

1. Be a high school junior in SkyLine's five-county service area (Alleghany, Ashe, Avery, Watauga or Johnson).
2. Have at least a 3.25 grade-point-average (GPA).
3. Exhibit demonstrated leadership in campus organizations.
4. Exhibit demonstrated interest in community through volunteer activities.

### **Application Requirements**

1. Complete a Youth Tour application.
2. Include with your application a brief letter, which states why you would like to attend and what your plans are beyond high school.
3. Include with your application a letter of recommendation from a teacher, youth leader or school official.
4. Write an essay of up to 300 words that addresses one of the following topics:
  - a. SkyLine is a member-owned telecommunications cooperative. What are the basic differences between a cooperative and other types of business. What is your general impression of SkyLine, based on your own knowledge and your review of information about the company that is included on its website ([www.skybest.com](http://www.skybest.com))?
  - b. What is your opinion of social media and its impact on society? Are there aspects of social media that have been beneficial to you?
5. Return these items, along with a recent school photograph of yourself, to your school counselor by Wednesday, April 1, 2020.

*NOTE: Children of SkyLine employees and directors are ineligible for consideration.*

### **Transportation Arrangements**

In addition to full sponsorship of the tour for two students, SkyLine will pay the airfare tickets to and from Washington, D.C. Additionally, the cooperative will provide \$75 to each of the participants to cover incidental expenses during their trip to Washington, D.C.
